Church Growth Through Bible Discussions—TODAY

John Magnuson, Communications Minister & Director at the North Boulevard Church of Christ in Murfreesboro, Tennessee is visiting us today. The Bible and History

The Bible claims that God cannot lie (Titus 1:2) and that God knows everything (1 John 3:20). So if the Bible is from God, that Bible has to be without error in its record. The Bible is filled with historical details that can be verified, from facts to locations to historical events and people. Historians around the world, modern as well as ancient, agree that the Bible is historically accurate. Archeologists even use the Bible to locate lost cities and to know what they are looking for. For example, atheists accused the Bible for being false for many years because of its inclusion of Pontius Pilate, the Roman official that oversaw the crucifixion of Jesus. There was no archaeological evidence that such a person existed. That is, until 1961 when the "Pilate stone" was discovered and verified the Bible's account. An Italian archaeological team working at Caesarea found a stone tablet that measured 32 inches high, by 27 inches wide, by 8 inches thick. On this slab were the remains of this simple title: "Pontius Pilate, Prefect of Judea"—almost the exact same title as the one given to him in Luke 3:1. As archaeology progresses and makes new discoveries, the Bible's history becomes increasingly verified. Even contemporary documentation verifies the Bible's claims. You may not have ever seen Jesus but you can know he existed because there is so much evidence he did. The New Testament is written by eyewitnesses and secondhand accounts of Jesus, but also many non-Christian documents were written that mention Jesus at that time too. Roman historians like Thallus, Cornelius Tacitus, Pliny the Younger, and Jewish history like the Talmud or the writings of Josephus all refer to Jesus. These were not believers--they were historians recording history. *Bobby Price*
