Sayings People Mistake for Scripture

"God will never give you more than you can handle." Generally, this is supposed to be a comforting statement to a person struggling in difficult situations. A quick survey of a few friends showed that almost no one finds this phrase remotely helpful, even if the person saying it has good intentions. And it's not scriptural. Many cite 1 Corinthians 10:13 as the basis for this sentiment. However, Paul is addressing the issue of temptation for Christians, and that God always offers us a way to escape them. If you consider that with God all things are possible (Mat. 19:26), this could be true and the Lord can make you able to endure anything. But this does not invalidate that many of the Gospel writers, even Jesus
