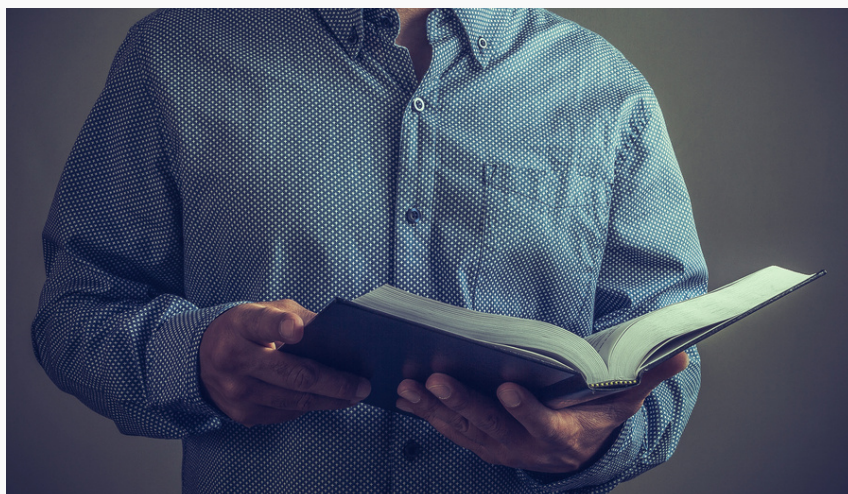

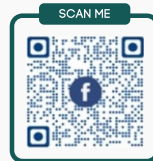


Prayer Requests
